

## **AutoClerk System Requirements Checklist**

AutoClerk's goal is for your property to have a solid installation that lasts for years. These specifications are not arbitrary. To endure acPMS functions and capabilities perform as specified, and for your protection, **make sure you Network Administrator (vendor) follow best practices regarding your network security.** See acPMS' PA-DSS Implementation Guide for details. It is located at <a href="https://www.myautoclerk.com">www.myautoclerk.com</a> on the Home page. acPMS requires your vendor have some level of Microsoft Certified Information Technology Professional (MCITP) certification.

AutoClerk technicians will **NOT** install the acPMS software on computers that **do not meet the minimum specifications as stated in 1-5 below.** If the specifications are not met, it will delay your installation and increase your costs. To avoid costly repairs and delays, please be sure:

- Your Network Administrator reads and follows acPMS' System Specifications found at <u>www.myautoclerk.com</u> on the Home page. They can also be found at the end of acPMS' PA-DSS Implementation Guide.
- You or your vendor order the correct equipment.
- The specified hardware is delivered.
- Your Network Administrator properly installs the ordered equipment.

Ensure your hardware meets the following five (5) criteria:

(Have your Network Administrator initial each of the five (5) items below and designate your server OS if applicable)

<b>PCs: Every PC must be business grade.</b> A 'home' version PC (like those found in 'Big Box' stores) may save money in the initial purchase but will ultimately cost you more in lost productivity and data.
Workstations: Every workstation PC must run Windows® 10 Pro (not Windows® 10 Home)

- ▶ acPMS RECOMMENDS a **dedicated server** for **all** installations for better data security & reliability.
- ▶ Networks of 3 stations must have a dedicated application server but have the option of using Windows® 10 Pro as the dedicated application server.

Network Interface Card: Every PC <u>must</u> have a Network Interface Card (NIC) made by 3Com, Intel or Broadcom and must be a gigabit or 100mb/sec. Lesser NICs have been known to cause data corruption. 4. Serial port expander: A serial port expander may be required depending on how many serial interfaces the property is purchasing. The expander must be installed on the **server** (or station 1 for those without servers). The only acceptable serial port expanders are the Digi board AccelePort Xr920, (Digi Neo for low profile solutions) or the Ionetworks Edgeport USB to multi-port RS232C. a. You can purchase an expander through **Technology At Work**. 5. Backup: acPMS recommends every installation have an external and/or removable media, and/or off-site backup solution. Optical drives (e.g., CD/DVD burners) must not be used for backups performed by the acPMS program! Please see separate documentation on www.myautoclerk.com for additional information on backups. Warning: If no other external backup service or removable media backup is performed, the hotel is at risk of catastrophic data loss in the event of a disaster, loss (hard drive crashes) or theft.
